Tours last approximately 75 minutes and will be by tour bus only. No private cars are allowed.  
Don't delay in registering as all previous tours sold out very quickly.

Tours for 2012 will **ONLY** be for the "Q" area, the area famous for the reputed storage of 'special weapons', i.e. atomic weapons! The 2012 tours will focus on the military history of the depot; however, there are many brown deer, hawks, pheasants, coyotes and a few white deer inside the "Q" area so wildlife lovers should not be disappointed.

Some highlights of our tours include:

- Visit **INSIDE** an igloo and experience the history it housed...see the igloos that housed the "special weapons".
- Listen to Military Policemen (MPs) talk about their duties protecting the "Q".
- The "Q", the most highly secure storage area for the Army and home to the atomic weapons, was the US Army's largest atomic weapon stockpile area in the United States.

**Directions to the Varick VFD for the Fall Tours**

Please arrive early to check in and check out our exhibits and gift items for sale.

**From the West:** Take NYS Thruway to the Geneva Exit (#42) and travel south on NYS 14. Look for signs for Rts 5&20 going East. Follow Rts 5&20 past the state park at the north end of Seneca Lake and just past the park turn right onto Rt 96A. Go 6.2 miles and the Varick VFD is on your right side. It is a large building with a red metal roof.

**From the East:** Take NYS Thruway to the Waterloo Exit (#41) and take Rt 414 south to the intersection of Rts 5&20. Turn right at light and go thru village of Waterloo and proceed for about five miles. You will see a Lowe’s on your right and a stop light. Turn left at the stop light and go 6.2 miles to the Varick VFD which will be on your right. It is a large building with a red metal roof.

**From the South:** From Ithaca travel north on Rt 96. Once you reach Ovid, follow Rt 96A north for about 10 miles. You will actually go past part of the Depot (on your right side) and the Varick VFD will be on your left side past the entrance (.5 miles) of the Hillside Children’s Center. It is a large building with a red metal roof.
